

SJC GUIDELINES FOR RESUMING MASS











In accordance with current Brunei Ministry of Health and Ministry of Religious Affairs guidelines (Places Of Worship Other Than Mosques And Surau – Operation Readiness Level 4 – 3 Aug 2020)

Please note that SJC guidelines will be updated as required







A. Before coming to Church

	Show patience and kindness. Please follow instructions at all times.
	Please download the BruHealth app and do a self-assessment at home. Only come to Church if you are code “Green” or “Yellow”. If you are unable to download the app because your device is not compatible, unfortunately, you and your family are not eligible to attend Mass at this time. You may use a family member or a friend’s device to scan in.
	Please register for the weekend Mass you wish to attend on the Mass Registration website. This will facilitate faster checking in of people before Mass begins. If you and your family are not registered, all of you will not be able to enter the Church for Mass on that day.
	Please stay at home and continue participating in online Masses if you are: ill with pre-existing uncontrolled medical conditions; currently pregnant; and young children below the age of 12.
	Please arrive at least 30 minutes before Mass begins for Registration and Temperature Screening. The Church compound gates will be closed five (5) minutes before Mass begins. All of you will be denied entry, and will need to re-register for another Mass.
	Please wear a face mask at all times whilst at Church, removing it only when consuming Holy Communion. This includes during arrival and departure from the car park.
 	Please bring wet / antibacterial wipes to clean and disinfect your seating area. Please bring your own hand sanitiser to use before entering the Church as the Church has limited supplies.
	Please bring your own Missal and a pen.
	Before coming and to limit the use of the Church facilities, please use your own toilet at home. However, if you wish to go to the toilet, please do so before Mass begins.






B. Upon arrival and before you enter the Church

	<p>Please wait in your car until you are called upon by the Mass Frontliner. Gentle reminder that you and your family will be denied entry if all of you are late and Mass has already begun as the gates will be closed.</p>
 	<p>Always maintain some form of physical distance between individuals/families. Please avoid mingling before and after Mass.</p> <p>Scan the SJC QR code to check in.</p>
  	<p>Registration and Temperature Screening</p> <p>I. You need to be registered for the day's Mass. Please bring along your email confirmation either printed out or on your phone. If you are not on the list, you and your family will NOT be allowed to attend Mass. Please do NOT show up if have not registered.</p> <p>II. You need to show that you and your family are code “Green” or “Yellow” on the BruHealth app. We will not be allowing any other colour admittance at this time.</p> <p>III. If you or any member of your family log a temperature of 37.5°C or above 3 times in a row or have any visible respiratory symptoms, all of you will be denied entry and be asked to leave.</p>
	<p>Seat Assignment</p> <p>You and your family will now be assigned a section and row number. Please note that all of you might not be able to sit together on the same row at this time.</p>
	<p>Please put your donations in the collection basket provided at the entrance of the Church. There will be no collection during the Mass.</p>
	<p>Please sanitise your hands before entering the Church.</p>
	<p>Entry into the Church is only through the Mercy Door.</p>

C. When you are in the Church and during Mass

	<p>Please sit only in the designated section and row assigned to you and your family. Leave space in between each person. Please do NOT move around.</p>
	<p>Please clean and disinfect your seating area with wet / antibacterial wipes before you sit down. Please properly dispose of the wipes at home.</p>
	<p>Hand holding during the Lord's Prayer and shaking of hands during the Sign of Peace is NOT allowed. It can be observed with a simple bow.</p>
	<p>Holy Communion can ONLY be received by hand. Please sanitise your hands before receiving and wait for the directions from the wardens.</p>
	<p>After receiving the Host, please move to the designated area marked on the floor. Remove your mask only in this area, consume the Host, and reset your face mask before returning to your seat. Please do NOT remove your mask as you approach the Sanctuary or in front of the priest or the EOM.</p>
	<p>Direction flow during Communion</p> <p>Church Sections A and B will be directed to the EOM on the left-hand side of the Sanctuary (near the font), indicated in the red area.</p> <p>Sections C will be directed to priest at the middle and Sections D and Choir at the right-hand side of the Sanctuary, indicated in green.</p> <p>Parish Hall Section E (on the left-hand side of the hall) will received Communion first and then section F (on the right-hand side of the Hall).</p>

D. Before you leave the Church

	Please clean and disinfect your seating area again with wet / antibacterial wipes before you leave. Please do NOT leave any rubbish in the pews.
 	Leaving the Church will be by sections. Please remain seated until directed by the Wardens to leave the Church. Section A will exit via the rear side door, Section B will exit via the Font door. Sections C, D and Choir will exit via the Mercy (entrance) door. Section E and F (Parish Hall) will exit from the main doors. Please do NOT mingle in front of the Church or in the car park after Mass and leave the car park as soon as safely possible
	Scan the SJC QR code / confirm leaving the premise upon exit.
	Please properly dispose of your masks and tissues / wipes at home.

NOTICE

Parishioners will **NOT** be permitted to enter if:

- X you are code "Red"; "Blue" or "Purple" on the BruHealth app.
- X you have a fever of 37.5°C or above and/or have any respiratory symptoms such as cough, runny nose, and sore throat.
