SOLEMNITY OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

FIRST READING

Ezekiel 34: 11-12, 15-17

Ezekiel is writing after the return from exile in Babylon, and it is apparent that neither the people nor their leaders had learned their lesson. As they became prosperous again, they also became corrupt and less concerned with such 'unprofitable' things as justice and mercy. Through the voice of the prophet, the Lord promises that he will lead his faithful himself. Having blamed the bad shepherds, God promises to gather all his scattered sheep, especially the most abandoned. For this he will raise up a new David.

SECOND READING

1 Corinthians 15: 20-26, 28

This passage is part of St. Paul's instruction on the resurrection of the dead. The effect of the resurrection is the restoration of all things in the order that God intended. Christ himself has already accomplished this restoration, but it is brought to completion only on the battleground of the human will if each person. Christ's royal power is to make people pass from death to life, to destroy the powers of evil, and bring all people together in God.

GOSPEL

Matthew 25: 31-46

After exhorting his followers to vigilance, preparation, and attentive ministry during the period of uncertain delay before his second coming, Jesus now speaks of judgment in terms derived from the daily life of a shepherd - the separation of sheep and goats into their own pens after a day of grazing together. The basic standard by which we will be judged is our recognition of one another as brothers and sisters in a genuine and active sense - what we do or fail to do for them springs from our attitude toward them, and ultimately, our attitude toward Christ.
