FIFTEENTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

FIRST READING

Amos 7: 12-15

Amos had an unenviable task in his mission. The kingdom in the north had been enjoying a period of great material prosperity. However, the rich increasingly became the only beneficiaries of this prosperity, while the poor got poorer. The situation deteriorated until the Lord sent Amos to Israel in the mid-eighth century B.C. he prophesied the fall of Israel's northern kingdom. Amaziah, the priest of the sanctuary at Bethel, banished him for his insolent utterances and ordered him to return to Judah.

SECOND READING

Ephesians 1: 3-14

Although the author is writing to specific individuals, there is no sense here that some are predestined for salvation and others are not. The point is that salvation in Christ is not an afterthought; it was in God's plan from the beginning. The believers were not chosen because they were holy and blameless but that they might be holy and blameless. Once again it is clear that salvation is the cause and not the consequence of righteousness.

GOSPEL

Mark 6: 7-13

This is an account of the first missionary venture of the Twelve. In it they are given some explicit directions on what to take with them on their journey and how to act. Although they are given the power to drive out unclean spirits, it is quite clear that they can only do this through the authority of Jesus. In other words, they are now commissioned to participate in the ministry of Jesus with the very power of Jesus. They are sent out as one in authority sends our delegates or envoys. The authority is not theirs, nor is the message. They are merely sent in place of the other.

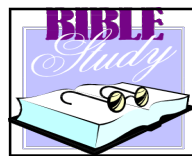
