INFORMATION NOTICE

The Department of Civil Aviation, Ministry of Transport and Infocommunications would like to inform the public and all passengers to adhere all rules, procedures and preventive measures as recommended by the Ministry of Health at Brunei International Airport in curbing with the spread of COVID-19 outbreak.

- All departing passengers are to be dropped off at the Departure Terminal. No accompanying persons are permitted.
- The public are strictly not allowed to pick-up or greet arriving passengers.
- All passengers are required to download the BruHealth application on their mobile devices and must scan the QR Code provided prior to entering the Brunei International Airport.
- Passengers who are not able to download the BruHealth application must fill in their personal details in the record book provided and submit proof of travel documentations as well as negative COVID-19 PCR Test Certificate (if required) prior to entering the Brunei International Airport.
- Members of the public who wish to transact at Brunei International Airport are required to download the BruHealth application and must scan the QR Code provided prior to entering the Brunei International Airport. Those who do not have BruHealth application are not permitted to enter the premises.
- All employees of the Brunei International Airport are required to download the BruHealth application on their mobile devices and must scan the QR Code provided prior to entering the Brunei International Airport.
- Employees who are not able to download the BruHealth application must show a valid employee ID and fill in their personal details in the record book provided. Employers are responsible in ensuring that their employees are fit to work and not categorized as Code Red (BruHealth Code – Personal Assessment Code).
