FIRST READING

Isaiah 62: 1-5

Today's first reading is the second poem from the book of Isaiah about the glorious resurrection of Jerusalem. Jerusalem was a lowly nation at that time. The wine from their grape they couldn't enjoy and the corn that they produced were fed to their enemies. The Jews were taunted constantly. But because of God they will be able to rise against their enemies. Jerusalem will be made the greatest among all nations. For God's favor rests upon them. They, the people will be called 'the Holy People', 'Yahweh's Redeemed'.

SECOND READING

1 Corinthians 12: 4-11

COMING TO MASS

All individuals above the age of 12-year-old with GREEN and YELLOW Bruhealth codes are allowed to attend. However, Individuals who are not fully vaccinated must have proof of negative ART from an approved ART Certification Center. Children under the age of 12 years old are not allowed to be present during congregational and other worship services. Due to the SOP, the church can only accommodate up to 300 people. The Parish Hall can accommodate up to 100.
