

FIRST READING

No. 29/22

Genesis 18: 20-32

THIS DIALOGUE BETWEEN God and Abraham gives us another picture of the way we should pray with persistence and confidence. The prayer that is answered is the one which displays a passion for the fulfilment of God's will, which is to save the just and to bring sinners to conversion. Although Abraham may seem to be trying to change God's mind here, what he really does is to remind God of his own intention to show mercy and reward justice.

SECOND READING

Colossians 2: 12-14

The total fullness of God lives in Jesus' human person with the result that believers come to 'fullness of life'. Paul reminds the Colossians of this wonderful experience of baptism, the new life which is an awakening from death. It is a life marked by forgiveness and a fresh approach to God because Christ has overcome all their enemies and accusers. The bond with its legal claims against them, is now nailed to the Cross.

GOSPEL *Luke 11: 1-12*

Jesus was not so concerned here to give instructions on how one ought to pray as he was to invite the disciples to share his own spirit of prayer, and to show them what sort of God it is who hears and answers our prayer. Persistent prayer opens us to get to know our needs as God sees them so he can fulfill them. True prayer as Jesus as Jesus taught leads our wills to conform to God's will rather than try to bend God's will to our own wants.
