

FIRST READING

No. 30/22

Ecclesiasticus 1: 1; 2: 21-23

The preacher takes an ironic view of human achievement. He speaks little about God, and his bleakness might be said to reflect the tragedy of human existence when all its spiritual resources have evaporated. In the portion of the book, the author asks why human beings expend so much of their energy on acquiring possessions. When death comes, he reasons, they must leave then to their successors, and all their striving proves to be an empty breath and a great evil.

SECOND READING

Colossians 3: 1-5, 9-11

The intimate relationship which baptism creates between the believer and Jesus means that we already share in Christ's glorious resurrection. The possession of this pledge of eternal life invites us to re-think our relationship to earthly power and possessions. Such action calls for risk-taking. We are invited to take a gamble on a life which, although it is hidden and only known by faith, is more real and lasting than what we know already.

GOSPEL *Luke 12: 13-21*

Jesus' fame as a wise teacher probably encouraged people to come to him for advice or to ask him to arbitrate in some of the practical dilemmas of life. The issue of inheritance rights in today's Gospel would have been just such a case. Jesus usually side-steps such a complex discussions of the Law in favour of a more radical approach. He warns his audience against the danger of greed and acquisitiveness which may have been ready to use the loop-holes in the Law to their own best advantage. He tells the parable of the rich landowner to show what can happen to people whose only rule has become the profit motive.
