FIRST READING

Amos 8: 4-7

Amos, a desert dwelling shepherd extremely sensitive to the injustice and exploitation and the great social gulf between the rich and the poor, condemns those who lurch in the false security of luxury. His prophecy is not merely an expression of envy of the have-nots toward the haves. Rather, he profoundly laments that complacency in material abundance has made the nation blind to impending destruction that is already visible just down the road.

SECOND READING

1 Timothy 2: 1-8

This passage about true faithfulness and true riches is sandwiched between two sections which provide a contrast of what is not true faithfulness or wealth. It leads into a doxology, a hymn of praise, in a way which gives Timothy a vision by which to live with hope. The central message is an assurance: the eternal life which Christ will offer at the last times, when he will reveal himself. To gain it, the disciple must fight the good fight of faith, persevere in hope.

GOSPEL

Luke 16: 1-13

The context of the parable is about the true values of life and knowing where to find them. The rich man misses the point in his own lifetime as do his brothers. They all have to learn to listen to the word of God if they are to be true to God and to Jesus. As Luke recounts it, moral behavior in itself has little to do with the ultimate destiny of these two persons. It is not what they do but what they are that counts.

Confessions is heard half an hour before the weekend Masses, i.e. 6:00pm on Saturdays; 7:00am, 9:30am and 5:00pm on Sundays.

WEARING FACE MASK

As announced by the Ministry of Health (MoH), that effective from 15th September 2002, use of face masks indoors or outdoors will be optional and no longer be made mandatory.
