C: Let us pray to God our Father who gives us his Spirit through Jesus his Son:

5. For our newly baptized and confirmed brothers and sisters that they may respond to the promptings of the Spirit, let us pray to the Lord.

6. For people feeling sad or anxious, for those deprived of consolation, for discouraged Christians, that they may appeal to the Holy Spirit for comfort, light and strength, let us pray to the Lord.

C: Let us pray:

All: Christ Jesus, before returning to your Father in heaven, you promised to send your Holy Spirit on your disciples. We are your disciples today - Pour out your Spirit into our lives so that we may reflect your grace and love and in this way, spread your Gospel to those whom we meet. Teach us to be your faithful disciples and animate us in every way with your Holy Spirit. Amen.

All: On my knees before the great multitude of heavenly witnesses I offer myself soul and body to You, eternal Spirit of God. I adore the brightness of Your purity the unerring keenness of your justice and the might of Your love. You are

the strength and the light of my soul. In You I live and move and am. I desire never to grieve You by unfaithfulness to grace and I pray with all my heart to be kept from the smallest sin against You. Mercifully guard my every thought and grant

that I may always watch for Your light and listen to Your voice and follow Your gracious inspirations. I cling to You and give myself to You and ask You by Your compassion to watch over me in my weakness. **Holding the pierced Feet of**

Jesus and looking at His Five Wounds and trusting in His **Precious Blood and adoring His** opened Side and stricken Heart I implore You Adorable Spirit Helper of my infirmity, so to keep me in your grace that I may never sin against You. Give

me grace O Holy Spirit, Spirit of the Father and the Son to say to you always and everywhere "Speak Lord for Your servant hears." AMEN.
