INTERCESSION DAY 3

C: Let us pray to God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ who sends His Spirit of adoption into our hearts to make us His sons and daughters.

4. For those hearts grown cold and indifferent because of their separation from God, that the Spirit might free them from unforgiveness and hate, let us pray to the Lord. All: Lord, hear our prayer.

5. For each one of us, that we may show our appreciation to God for the tremendous gift of knowing Him as our Abba, our Father by sharing the talents and resources He has given us with our brother and our sister in the Lord, let us pray to the Lord. All: Lord, hear our prayer.

6. For our parish community, that we may do our part to prepare our church to evangelise those who have not yet heard the Good News of Jesus Christ, let us pray to the Lord. All: Lord, hear our prayer.

C: Let us pray:

All: Christ Jesus, before returning to your Father in heaven, you promised to send your Holy Spirit on your disciples. We are your disciples today - pour out your Spirit into our lives so that we may reflect your grace and love and in this way, spread your Gospel to those whom we meet. With Your Spirit of Piety, may we find peace and fulfilment in the service of God while serving others. Amen.

All: On my knees before the great multitude of heavenly witnesses I offer myself soul and body to You, eternal Spirit of God. I adore the brightness of Your purity the unerring keenness of your justice and the might of Your love. You are

the strength and the light of my soul. In You I live and move and am. I desire never to grieve You by unfaithfulness to grace and I pray with all my heart to be kept from the smallest sin against You. Mercifully guard my every thought and grant

that I may always watch for Your light and listen to Your voice and follow Your gracious inspirations. I cling to You and give myself to You and ask You by Your compassion to watch over me in my weakness. **Holding the pierced Feet of**

Jesus and looking at His Five Wounds and trusting in His Precious Blood and adoring His opened Side and stricken Heart I implore You Adorable Spirit Helper of my infirmity, so to keep me in your grace that I may never sin against You. Give
